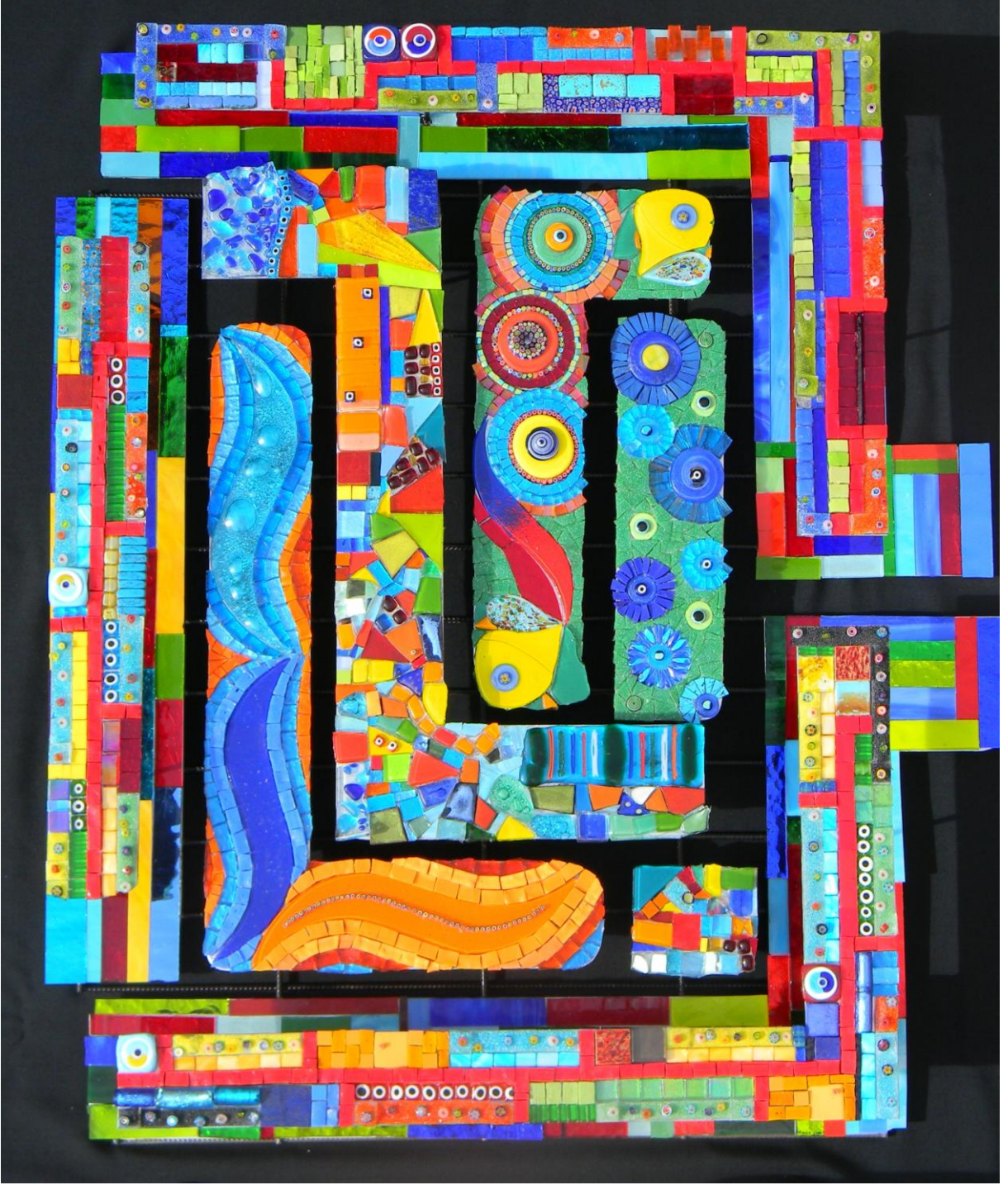

Her ne kadar eğitimi sanat dalında olmasa da tüm hayatı sanatla iç içe geçti. İsviçre,Fransa ve Amerika’da aldığı eğitim ona sanat adına çok bilgi birikimi kattı. Ailesinin de sanata olan ilgisi ve antika koleksiyonerliği yapması çocukluğunun antika dükkanlarında ve müzayedelerde geçmesine sebep oldu.

Bizzat kendi sanat hayatına beş sene evvel mozaik yaparak başladı. Bu daldaki eğitimini İstanbul ve İtalya’da yaptı.Ayrıca her yıl İstanbul’a gelen değerli mozaik sanatçıları Sonia King, Martin Cheek ve Emma Biggs’den de eğitimler alma şansı oldu.Ayrıca ünlü İtalyan mozaik sanatçısı Giulio Menossi’den de eğitim aldı.

Kendisi sanat ve mozaik tutkunu bir kiři. oęunlukla soyut tarzda alıřıyor ve yaratıcılıęı ve zgünlüęü ön planda tutuyor. Yapıtlarında kullandığı canlı renkler ve materyaller onu dięer mozaik sanatılarından farklı kılıyor.

İstanbul,Londra,Amsterdam ve Clauiano'da(İtalya) karma sergilere ve 1.Palermo Bienali'ne katıldı.Amerika'da da dört ayrı galeride alıřmaları sergilendi.

, originally born in South Korea, has shown her work internationally. She received her M.F.A. in Painting and Sculpture at Western Michigan University in 2000. Currently, InSoon is the proprietor of InSoon's Art Gallery & Design Studio in Middleville, Michigan. Her works shown regionally, nationally and internationally have garnered many awards and several best in show awards. She has taught at Western Michigan University and Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University. She has also been a juror, guest lecturer and committee member for the Fine Arts Center in Grand Rapids, Michigan. InSoon has been traveling to museums and galleries around the world for nearly 25 years. Recently she has exhibited her works in France, the United Kingdom, Denmark and Singapore. Her paintings and sculptures have been

installed in the International Juried Art Competition “ArtPrize” for 4 years in a row in Grand Rapids, Michigan. She has been selected for numerous solo and group exhibitions in Michigan and Portland, Oregon.

Sunsook Roh

is an installation sculptor and performance artist currently based in Singapore and New York. She has exhibited installation sculpture and did performance works in New York, Japan, Singapore and Korea. Selected exhibitions and performances include “The Reconstruction Biennial,” Exit Art, New York, “100 Years 100 Dreams, (centennial anniversary of Korean immigration to the U.S.),” Space World, New York, “Form,” Korean Cultural Center, New York, “JAALA Exchange Exhibition,” Tokyo Metropolitan Museum of Art, “Tree of Life V,” solo show at Sculpture Square, Singapore, and “2010 Asia Contemporary Art / Now and Next,” Guangju National Museum, Korea. She obtained a BFA majoring in Sculpture with a minor in Art History from Parsons School of Design, New York. She also obtained a MFA in Sculpture from Bard College, New York.
